- KJV Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the **kingdom of God**, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- KJV Acts 14:22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the **kingdom of God**.
- KJV Acts 19:8 And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the **kingdom of God**.

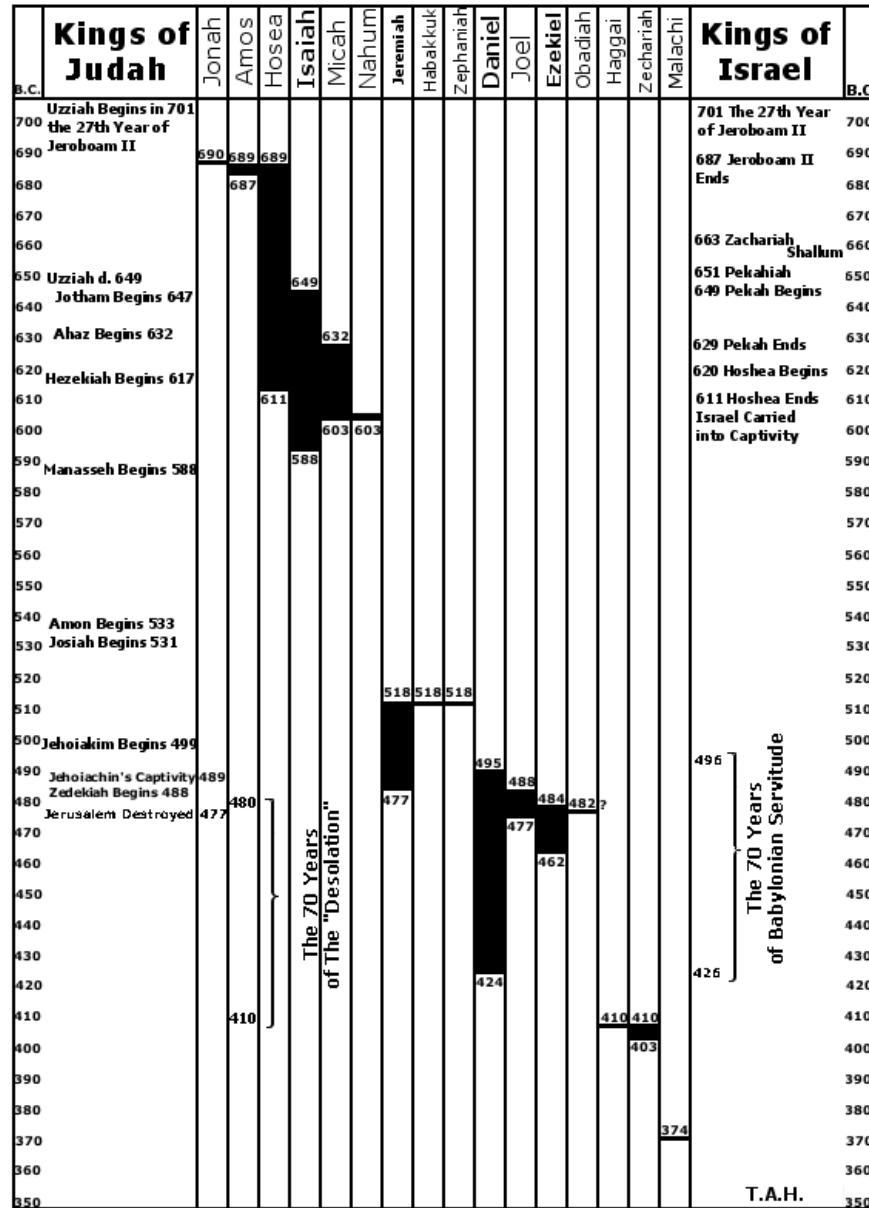

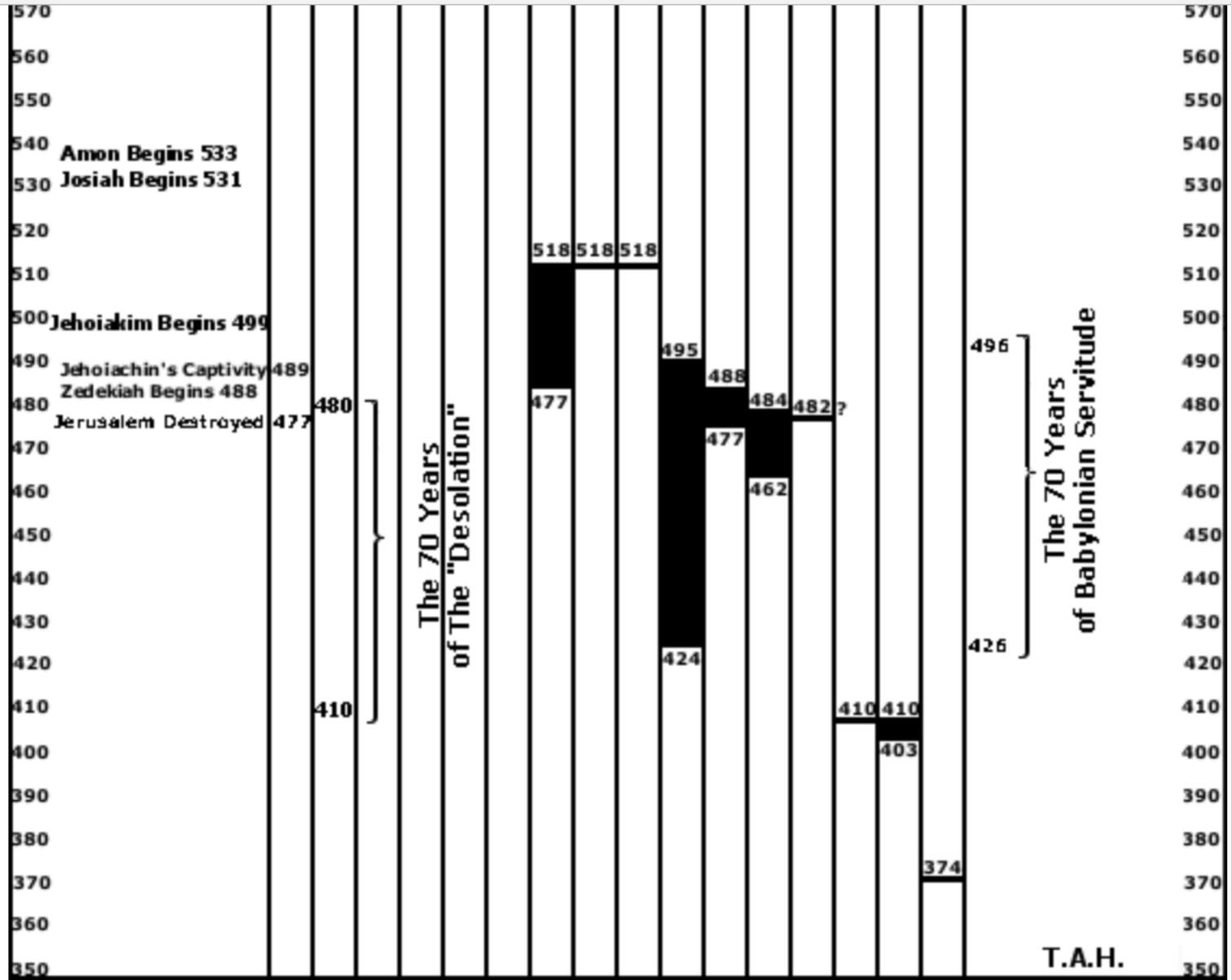

- ² For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;

NEGLECT

- KJV Hebrews 2:3 How shall we escape, **if we neglect** so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard *him*;
- KJV Hebrews 8:9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, **and I regarded them not**, saith the Lord.

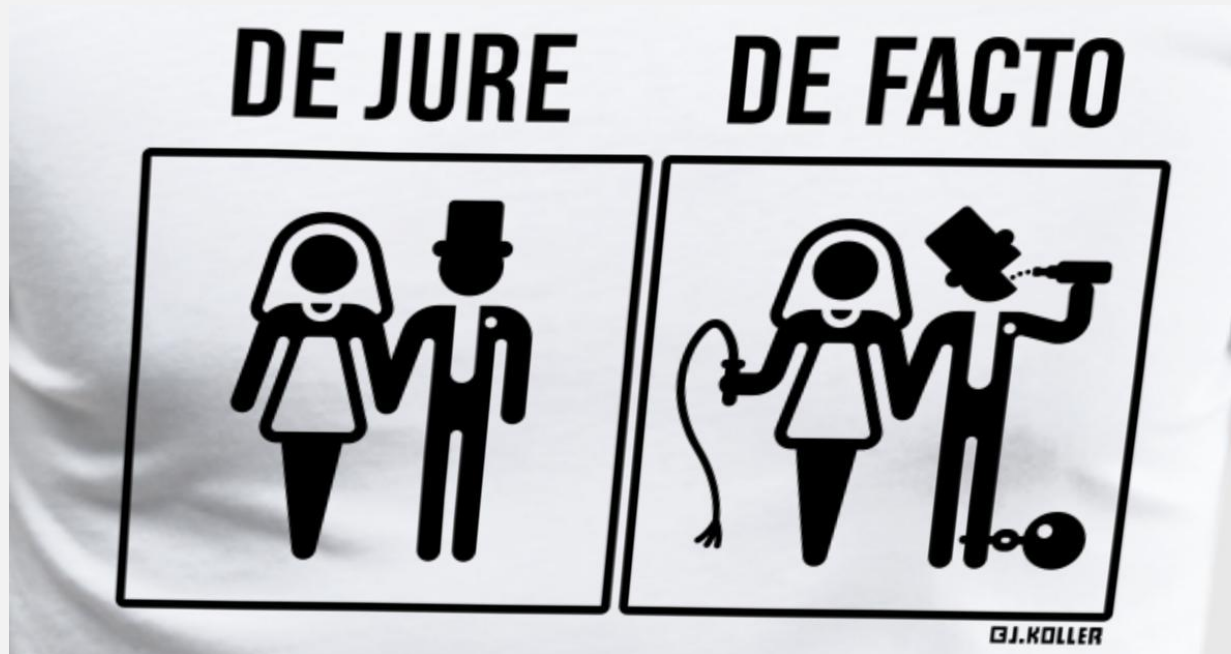

- ^{KJV} **Acts 13:46** Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves **unworthy** of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

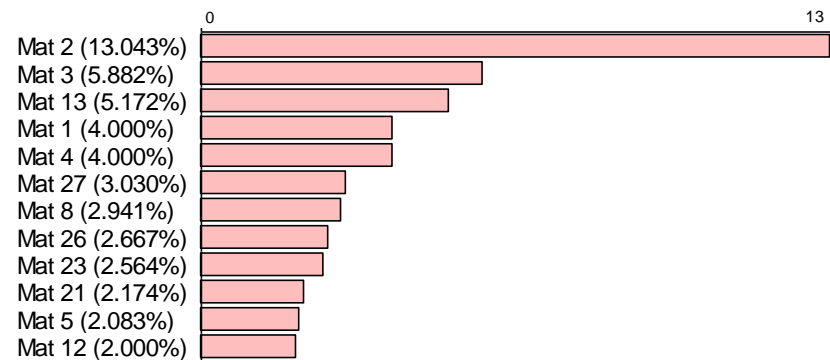

The people of Israel had reached the point when the blindness prophesied by Isaiah had begun to take effect. It is a matter of importance to note the peculiar word used by the Lord here that is translated "fulfilled". Up to Matt. 13: 14 the accepted formula "that it might be fulfilled" or "Then was fulfilled" translates the verb **pleroo**, and this on seven occasions (Matt. 1: 22; 2: 15, 17, 23; 4: 14; 8: 17 and 12: 17). Once only in the whole record of the Saviour's utterances, is there a departure from this rule, and that is made at Matt. 13: 14, where the intensive form **anapleroo** is employed. There is an element of completion about this word, as I Thess. 2: 16 will show. Even though the long-suffering of God waited throughout the whole period covered by the Acts of the Apostles and there was granted a stay of execution consequent upon the Saviour's prayer and the witness of Pentecost, it is not without significance, that when the Apostle in his turn quotes Isa. 6: 9, 10 in a similar context, namely, upon the rejection of Israel, the favourable mention of the Gentile, and the bringing in of the dispensation of the Mystery, he **does not say** "In them is fulfilled" but "Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto your fathers" (Acts 28: 25).
