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The people of Israel had reached the point when the blindness prophesied by Isaiah had begun to take effect. It is a matter of importance to note the peculiar word used by the Lord here that is translated "fulfilled". Up to Matt. 13: 14 the accepted formula "that it might be fulfilled" or "Then was fulfilled" translates the verb pleroo, and this on seven occasions (Matt. 1: 22; 2: 15, 17, 23; 4: 14; 8: 17 and 12: 17). Once only in the whole record of the Saviour's utterances, is there a departure from this rule, and that is made at Matt. 13: 14, where the intensive form anapleroo is employed. There is an element of completion about this word, as I Thess. 2: 16 will show. Even though the long-suffering of God waited throughout the whole period covered by the Acts of the Apostles and there was granted a stay of execution consequent upon the Saviour's prayer and the witness of Pentecost, it is not without significance, that when the Apostle in his turn quotes Isa. 6: 9, 10 in a similar context, namely, upon the rejection of Israel, the favourable mention of the Gentile, and the brining in of the dispensation of the Mystery, he does not say "In them is fulfilled" but "Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto your fathers" (Acts 28: 25).
