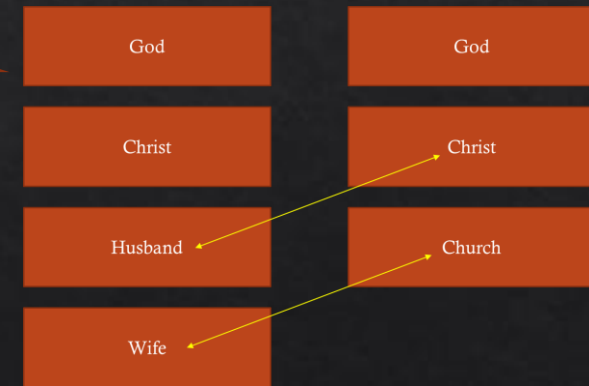

# Lineage, kindred, family

- ◇ KJV Lk. 2:4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and **lineage** of David:)
- ◇ KJV Acts 3:25 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the **kindreds** of the earth be blessed.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 3:15 Of whom the whole **family** in heaven and earth is named,

πατριά, ἄς, ἡ (1) as one's ancestry derived through the father family, clan, tribe (LU 2.4); (2) plural, in a broader sense of all peoples of earth, as deriving from God the Father of mankind families, nations (AC 3.25); (3) in a unique sense, as the idea of a group of people forming a family, patterned after God's fatherhood, family (EP 3.15)

# The Head

- ◇ KJV Eph. 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:
- ◇ KJV Eph. 1:22 And hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church,
- ◇ KJV Eph. 4:15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, *even* Christ:
- ◇ KJV Eph. 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- ◇ TBT Eph. 1:10 εἰς οἰκονομίαν τοῦ πληρώματος τῶν καιρῶν, **ἀνακεφαλαιώσασθαι** τὰ πάντα ἐν τῷ Χριστῷ, τὰ τε ἐν τοῖς οὐρανοῖς καὶ τὰ ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς·

# The comforter (The Holy Spirit and The Lord)

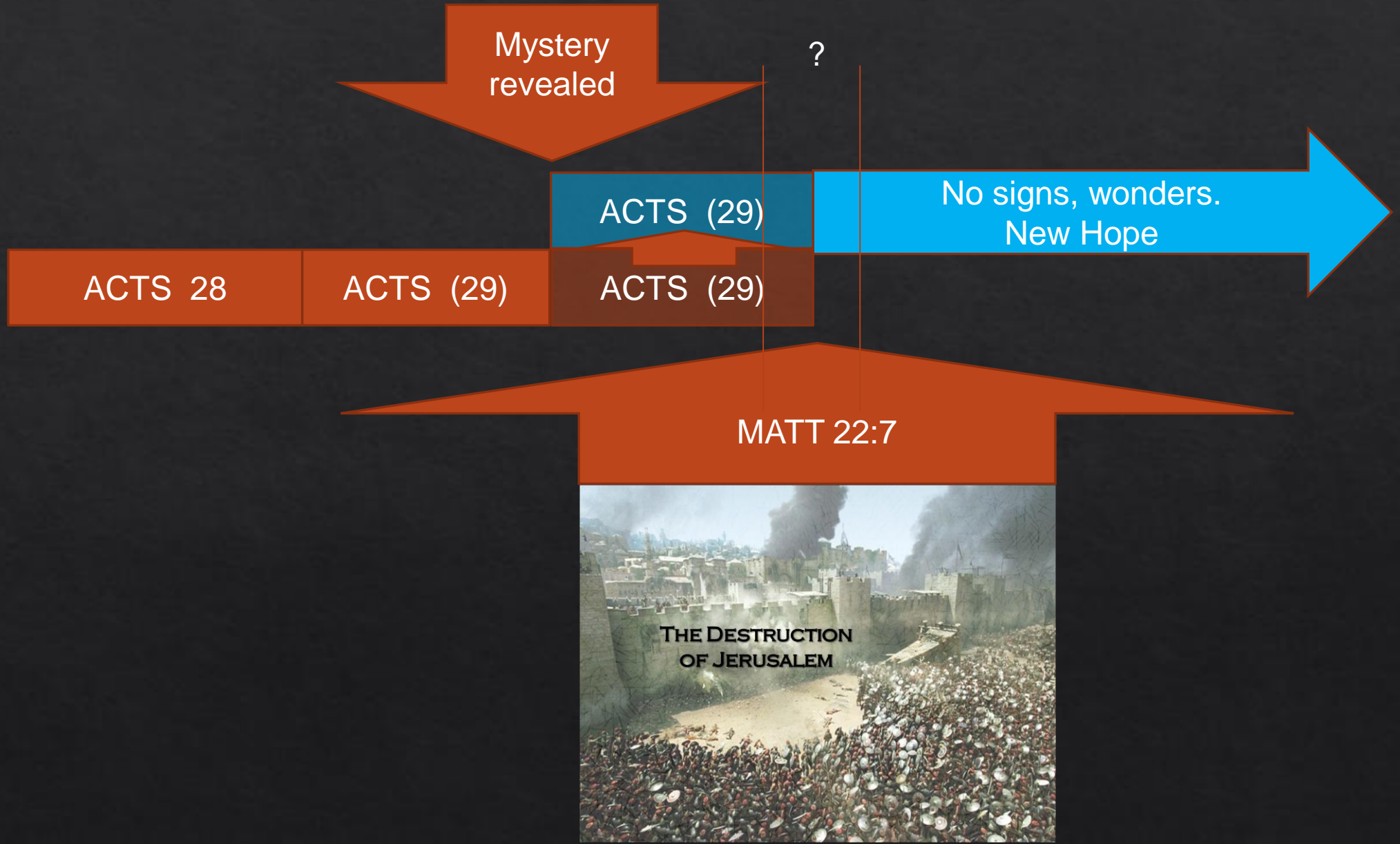
- ◇ KJV Jn. 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- ◇ KJV Jn. 14:26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- ◇ KJV Jn. 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, *even* the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
- ◇ KJV Jn. 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- ◇ KJV 1 Jn. 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

**σπουδάζω** fut. σπουδάσω; 1aor. ἐσπούδασα; intransitively; (1) with an infinitive following to show the area of urgency *make haste to, hurry to, do your best to* (2T 4.9); (2) with an infinitive following to show the area of concern *be eager to, make every effort to, try hard to* (HE 4.11)

# Psalm 68

- ◇ Setting is redemption from Egypt (see Vs 1,5,6,7, 12-14) – Pots (dual) – could mean kilns or piles of ashes in Egypt where they made vessels of clay.
- ◇ God who went “before” and “marched” Vs 7,8
- ◇ Enemies vanquished
- ◇ Sinai moved, angels (Vs 8,17)
- ◇ The God who rides above the heavens Vs 4, 33
- ◇ Emphasis on “the hill of God” Vs 15
- ◇ Emphasis on “dwell” – 4 times (6,16(2Xs),18) – God’s hill for Him to dwell (the holy place)
- ◇ Bringing “again” Vs 22 – Issues from death





# Sinai: Law was given by directed angels

- ◇ <sup>KJV</sup> **Galatians 3:19** Wherefore then *serveth* the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; *and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.*
- ◇ <sup>TBT</sup> **Galatians 3:19** τί οὖν ὁ νόμος; τῶν παραβάσεων χάριν προσετέθη, ἄχρις οὗ ἔλθῃ τὸ σπέρμα ᾧ ἐπήγγελται, διαταγείς δι' ἀγγέλων ἐν χειρὶ μεσίτου.
- ◇ <sup>KJV</sup> **Acts 7:53** Who have received the law by the disposition of angels, and have not kept *it*.
- ◇ <sup>TBT</sup> **Acts 7:53** οἵτινες ἐλάβετε τὸν νόμον εἰς διαταγὰς ἀγγέλων, καὶ οὐκ ἐφυλάξατε.

# Angels “viewing” – apostles are a “theatron”

- ◇ <sup>KJV</sup> **1 Corinthians 4:9** For I think that God hath set forth us the apostles last, as it were appointed to death: for we are made a spectacle unto the world, and to angels, and to men.
- ◇ <sup>TBT</sup> **1 Corinthians 4:9** δοκῶ γὰρ ὅτι ὁ Θεὸς ἡμᾶς τοὺς ἀποστόλους ἐσχάτους ἀπέδειξεν ὡς ἐπιθανατίους· ὅτι θέατρον ἐγενήθημεν τῷ κόσμῳ, καὶ ἀγγέλοις, καὶ ἀνθρώποις.

- ◇ <sup>KJV</sup> **1 Corinthians 6:3** Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?
- ◇ <sup>TBT</sup> **1 Corinthians 6:3** ΟΥΚ ΟΪΔΑΤΕ ὍΤΙ ἈΓΓΕΛΟΥΣ ΚΡΙΝΟΥΪΜΕΝ; ΜΗΤΙ ΓΕ ΒΙΩΤΙΚΑ;

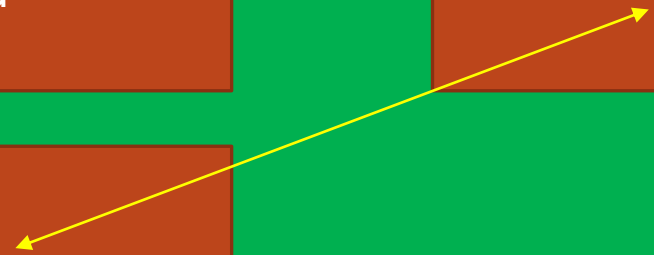
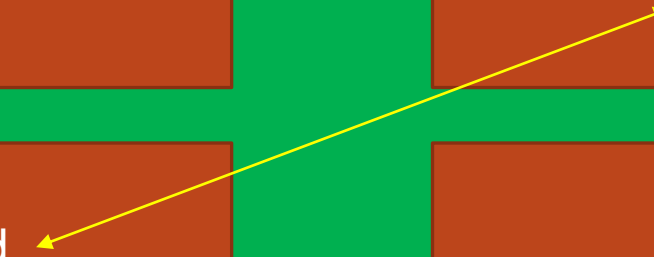

# Submit

- ◆ **ὑποτάσσω** 1aor. ὑπέταξα; pf. pass. ὑποτέταγμαι; 2aor. pass. ὑπετάγην; 2fut. pass. ὑποταγήσομαι; (1) active *subject, bring under firm control, subordinate* (RO 8.20b); (2) passive with a middle sense; (a) with a component of compulsion *have to submit* (LU 10.17, 20); (b) with a component of voluntary submission *be submissive, obey, subject oneself* (LU 2.51; EP 5.21)

# Concordance of “to submit” in Ephesians

- ◇ KJV Eph. 1:22 And **hath put** all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church,
- ◇ <sup>TBT</sup> **Ephesians 1:22** καὶ πάντα **ὑπέταξεν** ὑπὸ τοὺς πόδας αὐτοῦ, καὶ αὐτὸν ἔδωκε κεφαλὴν ὑπὲρ πάντα τῇ ἐκκλησίᾳ, (Eph. 1:22 TBT)
- ◇ KJV Eph. 5:21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 5:24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing.

# Imperatives in Chapter 6

- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;)
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:5 Servants, be obedient to them that are *your* masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:9 And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

# Mystery in Ephesians

- ◇ KJV Eph. 1:9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:
- ◇ KJV Eph. 3:3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,
- ◇ **KJV Eph. 3:4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ)**
- ◇ KJV Eph. 3:9 And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
- ◇ KJV Eph. 5:32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.
- ◇ **KJV Eph. 6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,**
  
- ◇ TBT Eph. 1:9 γνωρίσας ἡμῖν τὸ μυστήριον τοῦ θελήματος αὐτοῦ, κατὰ τὴν εὐδοκίαν αὐτοῦ, ἣν προέθετο ἐν αὐτῷ

# Tychicus

- ◇ KJV Acts 20:4 And there accompanied him into Asia Sopater of Berea; and of the Thessalonians, Aristarchus and Secundus; and Gaius of Derbe, and Timotheus; and of Asia, Tychicus and Trophimus.
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:21 But that ye also may know my affairs, *and* how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:
- ◇ KJV Eph. 6:24 Grace *be* with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. <To *the* Ephesians written from Rome, by Tychicus.>
- ◇ KJV Col. 4:7 All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, *who is* a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellowservant in the Lord:
