# Some evidence that the ends of the ages had been attained

- <sup>TBT</sup> **Matthew 16:28** ἀμὴν λέγω ὑμῖν, εἰσὶ τινες τῶν ὧδε ἑστηκότων, οἵτινες οὐ μὴ γεύσωνται θανάτου, ἕως ἄν ἴδωσι τὸν υἱὸν τοῦ ἀνθρώπου ἐρχόμενον ἐν τῇ βασιλείᾳ αὐτοῦ.
- <sup>KJV</sup> **Matthew 16:28** Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom.



# The condition

- **TBT Acts 3:19** μετανοήσατε οὖν καὶ ἐπιστρέψατε, εἰς τὸ ἐξαλειφθῆναι ὑμῶν τὰς ἁμαρτίας, ὅπως ἂν ἔλθωσι καιροὶ ἀναψύξεως ἀπὸ προσώπου τοῦ Κυρίου, <sup>20</sup> καὶ ἀποστείλῃ τὸν προκεκηρυγμένον ὑμῖν Ἰησοῦν Χριστόν· <sup>21</sup> ὃν δεῖ οὐρανὸν μὲν δέξασθαι ἄχρι χρόνων ἀποκαταστάσεως πάντων, ἧν ἐλάλησεν ὁ Θεὸς διὰ στόματος πάντων ἁγίων αὐτοῦ προφητῶν ἀπ' αἰῶνος.
- **KJV Acts 3:19** Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; <sup>20</sup> And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: <sup>21</sup> Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

# To repent: μετανοέω

- <sup>TBT</sup> **Matthew 4:17** Ἀπὸ τότε ἤρξατο ὁ Ἰησοῦς κηρῦσσειν καὶ λέγειν, **Μετανοεῖτε· ἤγγικε γὰρ ἡ βασιλεία τῶν οὐρανῶν.**
- <sup>KJV</sup> **Matthew 4:17** From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**

# “End” in Hebrews

- KJV Heb. 3:6 But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.
- KJV Heb. 3:14 For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;
- KJV Heb. 6:8 But that which beareth thorns and briers is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be burned.
- KJV Heb. 6:11 And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:
- KJV Heb. 7:3 Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

# 1 Corinthians: END, ENDS, END

- KJV 1 Cor. 1:8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- KJV 1 Cor. 10:11 Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.
- KJV 1 Cor. 15:24 Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

# τέλος

KJV Matt. 10:22 And ye shall be hated of all *men* for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

KJV Matt. 24:6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

KJV Matt. 24:13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

KJV Matt. 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

KJV Matt. 26:58 But Peter followed him afar off unto the high priest's palace, and went in, and sat with the servants, to see the end.

# 25937 συντέλεια, ας, ἡ as the point of time marking the close of an age end, conclusion, completion (MT 13.39)

- KJV Matt. 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.
- KJV Matt. 13:40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.
- KJV Matt. 13:49 So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just,
- KJV Matt. 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?
- KJV Matt. 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.
- KJV Heb. 9:26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

# Ex 23:14-16

- <sup>14</sup> Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year.
- <sup>15</sup> Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:)
- <sup>16</sup> And the feast of harvest, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and the feast of ingathering, *which is* in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.
- (Exod. 23:14-16 KJV)

- <sup>TBT</sup> **Matthew 13:39** ὁ δὲ ἐχθρὸς ὁ σπείρας αὐτὰ ἐστὶν ὁ διάβολος· ὁ δὲ θερισμὸς συντέλεια τοῦ αἰῶνός ἐστιν· οἱ δὲ θερισταὶ ἄγγελοί εἰσιν.
