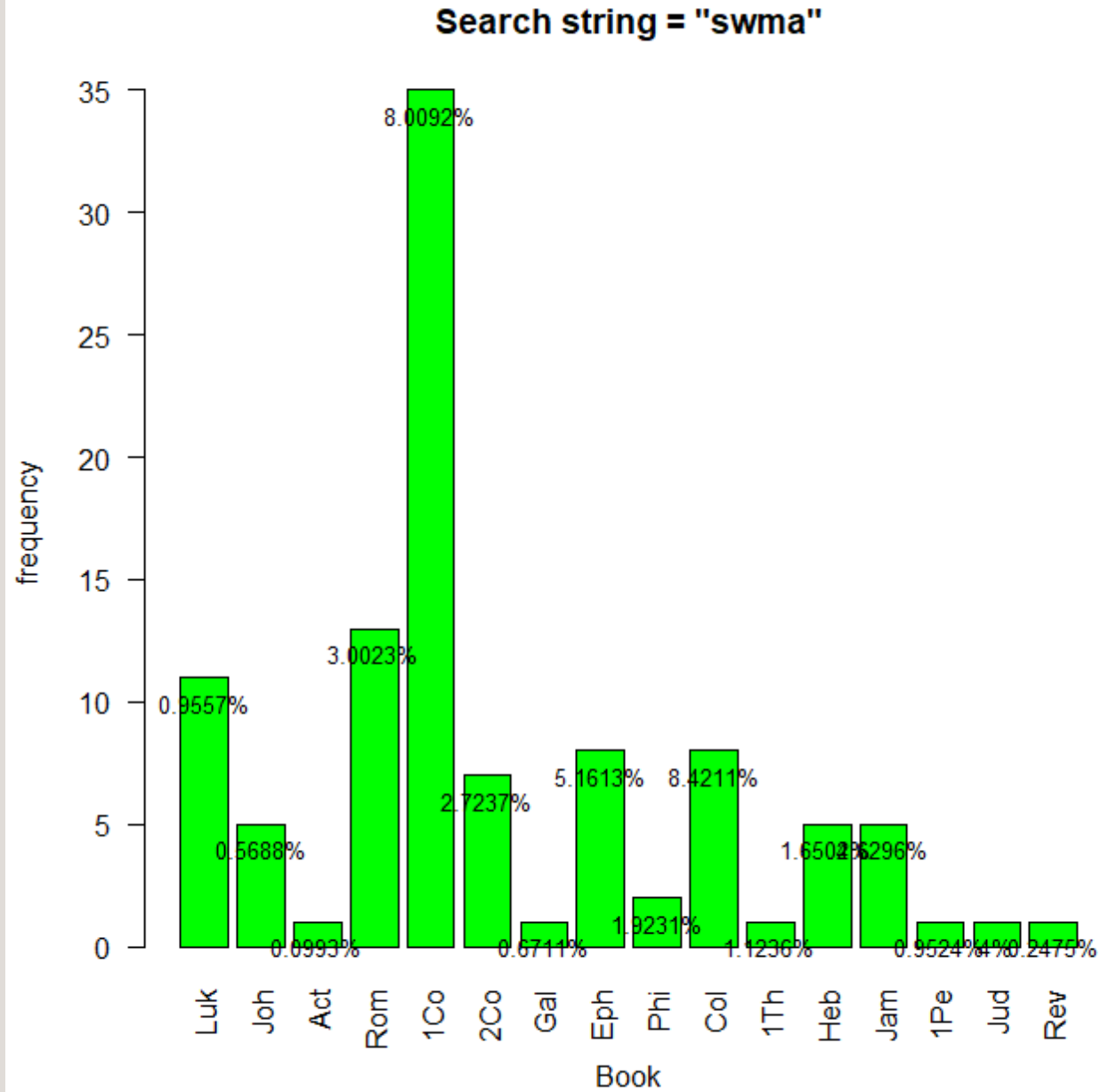
“Great fear came upon all the church”

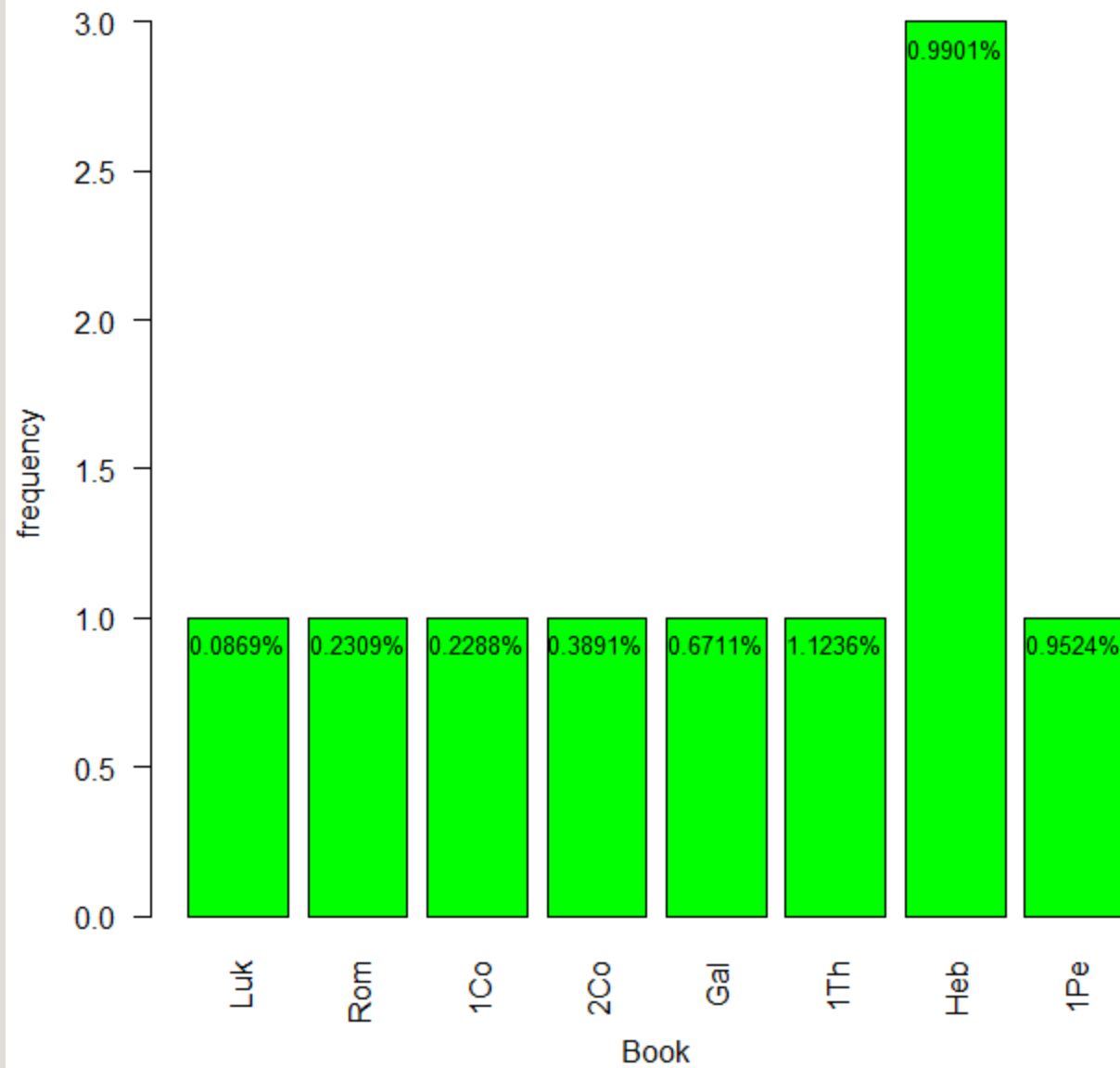

[Fri] καταρτίζω fut. καταρτίσω; 1 aor. κατήρτισα, mid. κατηρτισάμην; pf. pass. κατήρτισμαι; with a basic meaning thoroughly prepare something to meet demands; (1) put in order, restore to a former condition, mend, repair (MT 4.21; GA 6.1); (2) prepare, make ready, complete (HE 13.21); (3) create, arrange, prepare (HE 11.3); (4) as thoroughly equipping and adjusting Christian character perfect, fully qualify, make fully adequate (1C 1.10)
